
> Dancing at the Old Folks Home:

Bendigo Advertiser 6 Feb 1882

A Terrible Experience.

The mining manager of Mr. Lanseli's 180 claim, Mr. James Northcott, the well-known bandmaster had, on Saturday, a frightfully narrow escape from a terrible death. During the afternoon shift Mr. Northcott was being hauled up in the cage by the engine-driver. However, on reaching the surface the driver, with carelessness scarcely to be imagined, hauled the cage up to the wheels to the poppet-heads, notwithstanding that they are over 100 feet in height.

Fortunately one of Middleton's safety patent hook was attached to the safety cage, and as the hook went through the "thimble" it opened and the rope went flying into the engine room. The safety apparatus attached to the sides of the cage gripped firmly to the skids, and Northcott was held suspended over 100 feet from the brace of the shaft, and over 1,750 feet from the bottom of the shaft. He remained in this perilous position several minutes before he was released. Had the safety appliances failed to act Mr. Northcott would have been sent crashing over 1,750 feet below (the shaft being over 1,650 feet, and the poppet heads over 100 feet).

Notwithstanding this awful adventure Mr. Northcott was able to lead his band when performing on the Shamrock balcony on Saturday evening.
